



SUNFLOWER PLANTING TIPS

Sun lovers, these show-stoppers can reach 5 to 7 feet in height so plant along fences or anywhere you need a blooming wall.

Sow seed directly in soil after all danger of frost has passed, ideally after soil has reached 55 to 60 degrees F.

Space seeds about 6" apart in a shallow trench that's about 1"- 2" deep.

Cover seeds with soil and keep watered till seeds sprout in 7-14 days.

Sunflowers require regular watering and taller plants may require staking.

Cut flowers are beautiful in arrangements or leave blooms on the plant and allow birds to feast on the dried seed heads.
